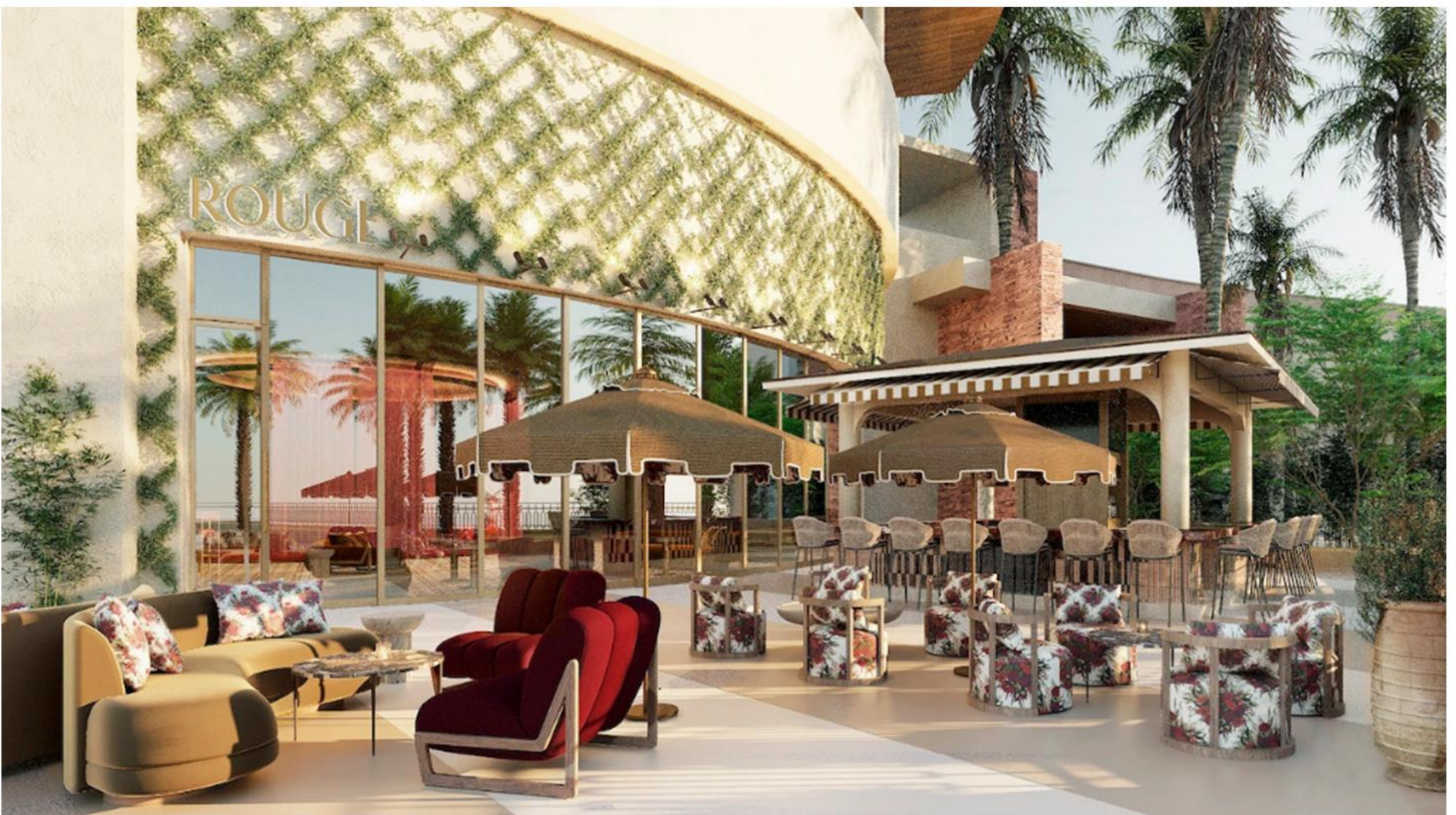
## OLD-WORLD EXTRAVAGANCE COMES TO LAS VEGAS AT SUMMERLIN'S ROUGE ROOM
